

# DEPARTMENT B CATTLE

Entries close 1<sup>st</sup> Friday in August at 5:00 p.m., Superintendents Robert Whitney and Karen Hargrave

Every exhibitor must purchase an exhibitor's ticket at \$6.00.

Entry Fee in this Department - \$2.00 Per Class

*Stalls and one bedding will be furnished free for all cattle exhibitors staying all week. Bedding will be available for purchase on the grounds*

**Rules and Regulations – All health papers will be checked by State Veterinarian.**

1. An entry fee of \$2.00 per class will be charged per entry in this department. Entries close 5:00 P.M., the first Friday in August.
2. The State Veterinarian will be available Wednesday 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. on Thursday.
3. All animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name. All registration papers will be called for upon arrival. Unless papers are ready when called for, animals cannot be shown in competition. **CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION WILL BE REQUIRED AT RINGSIDE AT TIME OF SHOWING FOR CLASSES 19 THROUGH 26 (PENDING PAPERS NOT ACCEPTABLE).** No Grade cattle shown in open class.
4. Animals must have been owned and cared for by the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the Fair.
5. All animals exhibited must meet the health requirements set forth on pages 9 -17.
6. The same animal may be exhibited only *once* in Classes 1 thru 14, but animals exhibited in these classes may be exhibited again in Classes 15 thru 26.
7. **POSITIVELY NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED** in this Department after the first Friday in August.
8. **NOTE TO EXHIBITORS:** For entries in Class 28, exhibitors must bring D.H.I.A. Herd Books so Superintendent may pick up records at Fair.
9. Two animals per class per exhibitor.
10. No hay stored in stalls (unless room permits).
11. All tattoo's must be plain.

**12. Exhibitors are responsible for cleanup at their area before leaving the Fairgrounds.**

**Time of Release:** No animals may be removed from the barns or loaded upon trucks until completion of show.
